PANAMA TO OPEN IN TEN DAYS

Panama, May 1.—Governor Goethals decided today to begin a barge service through the Panama Canal about May 10, thus bringing it into commercial use much earlier than had been expected.

The decision was brought about by the interruption of the Tehuantepec Railway route. The first freight to be towed through will consist of Hawaiian sugar, and it is understood that this will probably, in future, all be routed by the canal. During the past few days more freight has been offered, for trans-shipment through the canal most of it having formerly passed over the Tehuantepec route.

LARGEST AUTO ORDER GIVEN IN CANADA

What is said to be the largest order for automobiles ever given to a Canadian manufacturer, was closed recently by Assistant Sales Manager Armstrong, of the Studebaker Corporation of Canada.

The order calls for the delivery in Winnipeg of one carload of Studebaker automobiles, every day during the month of May. It is specified that every third car will be one of the new six-cylinder models. The balance of the order will consist of the new five-passenger, four-cylinder cars.

The automobiles in this single order are valued at \$126,850. Since this record-breaking order represents only one month's sales, it is estimated that the Studebaker cars distributed by the Breen Company during the season, will represent a total value of at least \$500,000.


