Prince Bismarck's Speech in the Reichstag Yesterday.

Germany Has No Cause to Fear an Attack.

REIN, Feb. 6. The announcement that Prince Bismarck would speak on the militia bill drew a great throng of people to the Reichstag yesterday. Prince William of Prussia and Prince Leopold (son of the late Prince Frederick Charles) occupied the front seats, while the diplomatic gallery was crowded with different foreign representatives and their families. Prince Bismarck was enthusiastically greeted on his way to the Reichstag by dense crowds which lined the route along Wilhelmstrasse.
