BRIDAL COUPLE OF A FORTNIGHT TIRED OF LIFE

Man Dead and Woman in Critical Condition as Result of Suicide Pact.

New York, Nov. 1.—A suicide pact entered into by a despondent young couple on the upper west side of the city, and carried into at least partially successful execution was revealed this afternoon, when a relative of Mr. and Mrs. Torrea broke into their rooms. Torrea was found dead in bed and his young wife, partially overcome by gas, and a wound in the left wrist, calmly waiting for her life to end.

When Mrs. Torrea was revived in the hospital to which she was taken a prisoner, she said that the knife wound had been inflicted by her husband in the carrying out of a suicide agreement which they made this morning. She told the police that her husband had first cut a deep incision in her left arm and then slashed his own right arm. He then turned on the gas and they lay down to die.

The Torreas were married only on Oct. 17 last. The smell of escaping gas from the room led to the discovery of the dead man and his wounded wife.

If the tender be not accepted the cheque will be returned.
