YOUNGSTERS FAST

The L. A. A. rugby squad is as level-headed in the dressing-room as it is on the field. There is talk of the first intermediate championship to come to London since blanketed Indian braves used to stand around looking at the work of the team, but there is much more conversation concerning Saturday's game and that four-point lead the locals have to wipe away before there is any chance of a victory.

The L. A. A. squad realizes that while they are a much stronger team than they were a month ago, Sarnia is also much stronger and no longer torn by dissension. They also realize that while the Sarnia backfield may be a strong department, they themselves have an edge in line play and the punch behind it. And a good line will blanket the best back field in the world any day.

The London players will go into the fray Saturday better drilled than the Sarnians, because they've realized that they've got to depend on the perfection of their play as a machine rather than upon the work of individual stars.

At last night's practice the halves were given drill against tackling. Joe Barrett booted spirals, twisters and bad bouncers, and the London halves ran them out nicely against the tackling that was set at them by Jerry Goodman, who has been asked to do a good deal of ball-carrying through the line as well as the kicking, will probably share the booting with Ernie Dennis.

Garrison A.A. To Introduce Indoor Soccer This Season

Games Will Be Staged in the Armories Every Monday Night.

CHAIRMEN NAMED

In indoor soccer London sport followers will this winter witness something entirely new in the way of athletic competition. The Garrison A. A. at its meeting last night decided to place this sport on the calendar for the season. It has never been attempted in this part of the country heretofore, but in the Maritimes it is meeting with decided success. In one game in Halifax last year 4,000 spectators were present. Staff Sergeant Ed. Sheard was named chairman in charge of this division, which fact augurs well for its success. A game will be staged each Monday night in the armories.

It is played under soccer rules in the main, the offense and out of touch regulations being amended to suit floor space. The number of men on each side is also optional, depending upon the size of the playing field. In Halifax nine men a side are used, but for the local floor the committee has tentatively fixed the number at six. The ball used is several sizes smaller than the regulation outdoor ball and not bown so hard. Rubber soled shoes are used by the players.

Chairmen of other committees were elected as follows: Basketball, Capt. Wooding; boxing, Staff Seret. Burns; track, Major G. A. Smith; indoor baseball, Staff Seret. Burns; hockey, Staff Seret. Burns.

FIVE FIGHTERS ARE SUSPENDED

Powell, Nagle, Friedman, Lewis and Schwartz Barred in New Jersey.

Trenton, N. J., Nov. 4.—Five boxers were suspended from participating in New Jersey bouts for a period of six months by the state boxing commission today. Notice of the suspensions has been sent by Boxing Commissioner Newton A. Burbee to all boxing clubs and managers.

Ray Powell and Carl Nagle, both of Philadelphia, were banned on complaints that followed a boxing show in the Bridgeton armory, Oct. 24 last. Powell was accused of employing wrestling tactics, and Nagle was charged with fouling.

The suspension of Johnny "Kid" Lewis, Izzy Schwartz and Felix Friedman, all of New York, was the result of a card staged by the Perth Amboy boxing club on Oct. 6 last. Lewis, according to Inspector Sosin, refused to weigh in when told, and lied about having weighed in earlier. Schwartz was said to have been late in appearing for the show and giving an "altogether unsatisfactory exhibition" when he did get there, while Friedman was guilty of fouling after being warned by the referee.
