

Li Hung Chang to Resign the Vice-royalty—Retreat of the Defeated Forces.

SAN FRANCISCO, Nov. 27.—Correspondence of the United Press per steamer Cosmo says:

Fenghuang was captured by the Japanese on October 23. Confronting the spoils of the conquest of Yalu, they found 55 cannon, 15,000 stand of arms, 100,000 rounds of small gun ammunition, 2,500,000 rounds of small arm ammunition, 300 tents and a large amount of stores of grain and provisions. Their total casualties had been one officer and 100 men killed, one soldier drowned and four officers and 87 men wounded.

Chinese had left 200 dead and 7 wounded upon the field, but contrived to carry off the rest of the wounded. No serious obstacle, except, perhaps, winter, now seems to hinder the Japanese advance.

Fenghuang is a walled town with 200,000 inhabitants, 35 miles north of the Yalu river. It had the reputation of being

"Resolved, that we earnestly petition His Excellency Grover Cleveland to instruct our minister at Constantinople to investigate this matter, either by sending to Constantinople a special agent, or by joining in a commission sent by the United European powers."

The resolution proceeds with an appeal to the signatory powers, and especially Great Britain, for the enforcement of the Berlin Convention of 1878.

A letter dated Bile, October 2, received by Secretary Gullion of the United Friends of Armenia, states that on the day previous a letter from Mouch had been received, which told of the outbreak of a virulent form of cholera, which was taking from twenty-five to thirty-five persons daily.
