Northland Exploration

OTTAWA, May 3.—Charged with the exploration, not only of its mineral, lumbering and power-producing possibilities, but also of its farming land, and with a view to ascertaining the feasibility of constructing two railways which would develop the immense resources of the country, the "Northland Exploration" branch of the Interior department has sent out an expedition which has now arrived at Edmonton to investigate the vast district north of the provinces of Alberta and Saskatchewan.
