A Fuss About a Treaty. Apparently the whole American press is in arms this week on the subject of the Spanish treaty.

The treaty was sent to the senate on Wednesday, and was referred to the committee on foreign relations and ordered to be printed.

The treaty is supported by that section of the republican press favorably to President Arthur, or not particularly opposed to him.

Opponents of the treaty argue that the American consumer would not gain a cent by dropping the duties on Cuban sugar, because the difference would be at once grabbed by the Spanish authorities and the large dealers.

The democrats, again, do not seem to be at all eager to help President Arthur in the quarrel with some important sections of his own party.
