

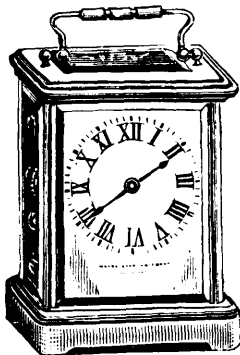

### TRAVELING CLOCKS.

**F**EW articles produced in any branch of manufacture will compare, as examples of skill, thoroughness, beauty and perfect finish of workmanship, with the better class of French traveling clocks. Of the different varieties of movements and of casings of these clocks a good assortment is always kept in hand. The cheaper varieties are not kept, as they rarely give satisfactory service, and are productive of annoyance and expense to both buyer and seller.



The cases are plain, gilt and crystal. The price always includes a red morrocco case. The movements fall chiefly into three classes :—

**Of those that do not Strike nor Alarm :**

1. White Dial,  $5\frac{1}{4}$  inches high.....\$13.25
2. Cream Enamel Dial,  $3\frac{1}{2}$  inches high..... 14.65

**Of those that Sound an Alarm :**

3. White Dial,  $4\frac{1}{4}$  inches high ..... 13.25
4. White Dial,  $5\frac{1}{4}$  inches high ..... 19.60

**Of those that Strike the Hours and Half Hours :**

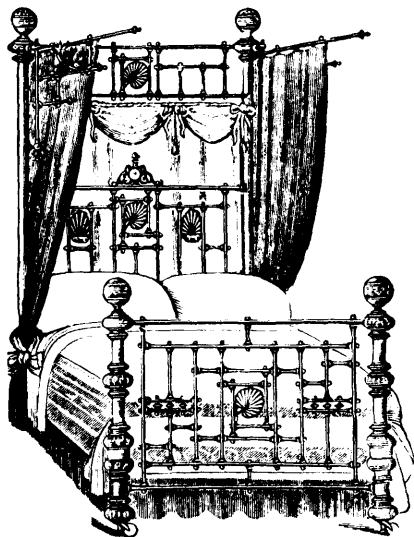
5. White Dial,  $4\frac{3}{4}$  inches high ..... 22.00
6. White Dial,  $5\frac{1}{4}$  inches high, strikes hours and half hours and alarms..... 25.50
7. White Dial,  $5\frac{1}{4}$  inches high, alarms, and strikes hours and quarters on 2 gongs, and on pressure of a spring repeats hours and quarters..... 32.50
