

2. Differences which may arise in the implementation of the provisions contained therein shall be settled by negotiations between the Government of Canada and the Government of Colombia, or in such other way as may be mutually accepted by the parties to the present Agreement.

ARTICLE XII

The present Agreement and the annexes hereto may be amended by agreement of the parties. The annexes to the present Agreement may also be amended by exchange of letters between the parties or between their designated agencies, provided that such amendments shall be within the scope of the present Agreement.

ARTICLE XIII

The present Agreement shall enter into force on the date of the exchange of notes by which the Government of Canada and the Government of Colombia notify each other that all formalities in respect of the present Agreement have been complied with, and shall remain in force unless terminated by either party on six months notice to the other party. Such termination shall not affect the validity of the contracts already concluded or the guarantees already furnished under the terms of this Agreement.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the undersigned, being duly authorized by their respective Governments, have signed this Agreement.
