

Sir John Crawford, an Australian economist and specialist in international affairs, has been his country's representative on several international organizations, such as FAO, where he was a founding delegate, and GATT. Former Vice-Chancellor of the Australian National University, he also was director of that university's Research School of Pacific Studies from 1960 to 1967. He was Permanent Secretary to the Australian Department of Commerce and Agriculture and the Department of Trade from 1950 to 1960. He has been a member of the IDRC Board of Governors since 1970.
