Adjournment Debate

This Liberal resolution on NATO was raised at a Standing Committee on National Defence meeting on December 2 last where the Associate Minister was asked what the Government's reaction was. I think the Associate Minister's answer bears repeating. He said that the present Party in power which forms the Government of today supports NATO completely and absolutely.

Finally, let me say that Canada as a founding member of NATO has a long history within this important organization,

and we see no reason to alter our strong support and commitment to it now.
