I am informed that the "Star" has declined to publish the full results of the McGill examinations. They have always done this in previous years and it is, of course, a fine thing for us and for the students concerned. We ourselves publish a pamphlet giving these results and send a copy to each student, but this cannot be issued for some weeks. The reason why the "Star" objects to continuing the service is that the detailed report occupies three or four pages of their paper.
