Unclaimed moneys paid over to Receiver General

Payment to person entitled. -every such transaction, pay the money unclaimed in respect thereof to the Receiver General, and it shall form part of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of Canada. "8. If a claim to money so paid is thereafter established to 5

the satisfaction of the Treasury Board, the Governor in Council shall, on the report of the Treasury Board, direct payment thereof to the person entitled thereto.

Company discharged. "9. Upon payment to the Receiver General the company shall be discharged from further liability in respect of such 10 money.

Penalty for making false "10. Every person who, knowing it to be false in any particular, signs any such return shall be liable upon conviction to a fine not exceeding one thousand dollars, and upon default of

payment to imprisonment for a term not exceeding two years, 15 or to both fine and imprisonment."
