In SUPPORT of the

## WAR in GERMANY.

**T**HAT *France* is more populous than *Great-Britain* and all the territories belonging to it, is an undoubted proposition ; altho' deducting the useless hands from the stock of each nation, the disproportion is not so formidable as is generally apprehended by us. In all our wars upon the continent of *Europe* with this power, we have had one advantage, which has more than evened that difference : Our armies have been chiefly composed of foreigners. We have fought *France* with *English* treasure, but not with *English* blood ; and while her natives were dragged from the plough and the loom to exercise the musquet, and perish or be disabled in the field, ours were employed in the arts of
