not exceeding Ten Pounds, currency, for each and every such offence. Provided always, that when disease, the apprehension of disease, or any other necessary cause shall require, that a vessel or vessels be funigated, application may be made to this Corporation, any three of whom may give permission for that purpose, upon good reasons assigned, under such regulations as to them may appear expedient.

That the Master or Commander of any vessel arriving from Harbour Master's sea, shall sign the Report of the Harbour Master, and if any such Master or Commander shall refuse so to do, he shall incur a penalty not exceeding Five Pounds, currency.
