has undertaken to furnish for such purposes, and which has been approved by the Commanding Officer, shall thereby incur a penalty not exceeding thirty dollars for each offence.

89. Any person who unlawfully disposes Unlawfully disposing of of or removes any Clothing, Arms, Accoutre-Arms, &c. ments or other articles belonging to the Crown, or who refuses to deliver up the same when lawfully required, or has the same in his possession, except for lawful cause, (the proof of which shall lie upon him) shall thereby incur a penalty of ten Not to pre- dollars for each offence; But this shall vert indictnot prevent such offender from being indictment. ed and punished for any greater offence if the facts amount to such, instead of being subjected to the penalty aforesaid ;-And Arrest of offender any person charged with any act subjecting about to him to the penalty imposed by this section leave the Province. may be arrested by order of the Magistrate before whom the complaint is made, upon affidavit shewing that there is reason to believe that such person is about to leave the Province, carrying any such Clothing, Arms, Accoutrements or articles with him.

Contravening this Act is not called out for actual service, wilfully where no other penal- contravenes any enactment of this Act or ed. any regulation or order lawfully made or given under it, when no other penalty is imposed for such contravention, shall there-
