PRICE-McCORMICK FAILURE.

A Bit of Romance Crops Up in Connection With the Suspension of the Firm.

MR. PRICE IS TO BE MARRIED TO-DAY

Wedding Had Been Fixed for Monday, But Was Hastened Rather Than Delayed.

New York, May 25.—It is improbable that the assignee of Price, McCormick & Co., the brokerage house which failed yesterday, will be able to issue a statement of the failure today. A force of expert accountants and clerks worked on the books the greater part of last night, and the indications are that it will be a day or two before a statement can be prepared for the creditors.

The Marriage Hastened.
Theodore H. Price, the head of the collapsed firm, announced today that his marriage to Miss Eugene Dyer, which was to have taken place on Monday next, in the Church of the Epiphany, will occur to-morrow.

Last night Mr. Price was to have given a farewell bachelor dinner, but it was suddenly called off.

The return of Mr. Stuart-Wortley, one of the partners in the firm, from Europe, which was expected to-day, had been timed so that he would not miss the wedding, for which the entire office force of the firm had made the most extensive preparations. The wedding present from the office staff to the senior partner had been ordered and paid for.

Hard Luck Stories.
In respect of this second hard luck story were told yesterday afternoon. The employees had collected \$575 for the gift, which was of silverware, and the order was placed with a prominent manufacturing company. In order that payment might be made at the time the order was placed, some of the clerks and bookkeepers borrowed money to pay their subscriptions rather than wait until to-day, which was the regular pay day of the firm. Of course, employees, under the law, are the first creditors to get their money, but there must be delay, necessarily.

Message on the Door.
The down-town office of Price, McCormick & Co. was closed to-day, and on the doors were notices directing all persons to the assignee and his counsel for information.

Private advices from San Francisco state that the losses there in cotton and stock thru the failure of the firm will probably aggregate about \$500,000. In the cotton trade it was the opinion that the extent of Price, McCormick & Co.'s outstanding contracts are not likely to exceed \$400,000.

RELIEF OF LUCKNOW, ONT.,

May 26.

Was Accomplished May 24, 1900, When the People Gave Vent to Their Loyal Feelings.

THE TOWN IN HOLIDAY ATTIRE.

Road, Yeldt and Kop Represented, and the Queen and John Bull Were There.

Locknow, Ont., May 25.—The historic relief of Lucknow called forth no greater demonstration of enthusiasm in the British Empire than did the outbreak of pent-up loyalty displayed by our citizens yesterday. It was a gala day, the citizens, let loose, became a general reception committee and received visitors with open hospitality. The booming of cannon and a general illumination of fire works the evening before began the program and spread up a martial spirit, which continued until midnight. The town was arrayed for the occasion in holiday attire, flags and bunting everywhere. A character street parade was advertised for the forenoon.

A Little of South Africa.
From early morning onwards crowds began to gather and they were not disappointed, for never in the history of our village was there such a complete parade. The companies and detachments assembled in the agricultural "veldt" to the east of the town and by 11 o'clock had appeared on the "kop" at the entrance to the town. In something like the following marching order: Brass band, the village road council, and officials in carriages, municipal fire brigade, Highland pipers band, Great Britain and Canada mounted as follows: John Bull, Magistrate Lawrence; Sandy, Alex. McPherson; Pat, E. Hedi; Johnny, Canuck, W. Miller; Queen Victoria in May Day reception character, L. Guardia, mounted; Lancers, Prince of Wales' Brass Band.

After That the Children.
After these came companies of children in patriotic chorus and a trades representation, followed by masquerade and original novelties, interspersed by chariots and national character bands, flanked on both sides by bicyclists, bedecked with garlands and streamers in patriotic colors. The whole presented a moving panorama in which every character was voted complete and a distinct addition to the demonstration. The parade reached about twice the length of the principal street and was in charge of James Bryan and J. Murchison, who were mounted in character to represent two of Britain's generals now in active service.

The afternoon was taken up with football, horse racing and music, and in the evening a popular concert of songs, music and dancing, with Mr. Bert Harvey of Toronto as chief entertainer, closed a day of pleasure to visitors, and one that would have warmed the heart of Her Majesty if she had been present.

CANADIAN PAVILION AT PARIS.

The Building Was Opened Without Ceremony—The Fair Section Greatly Admired.

Paris, May 25.—(Telegram Cable)—Canada's pavilion at the Exposition was opened yesterday without ceremony. Thoroughly visited the fair section, and it was greatly admired.

The Queen's Birthday was celebrated in the evening with a dinner, which proved to be most enthusiastic and patriotic. British Dominion and the representatives from India and Australia joined in the celebration.

TERRIFIC BEAR FIGHT.

Bear Probably Fatally Injured One Man and Badly Hurt Another.

Man and a Woman.

Sherbrooke, May 25.—The story of a thrilling encounter with a bear comes from Chatham, Que., 18 miles from Sherbrooke. It occurred on May 10. Mr. Charbonneau, who had had a number of sheep killed by bears, set a trap near his barn, hitching it with a chain. On the evening of the 10th, Mr. Charbonneau went to the barn to look after his stock and found that he had caught Mr. Bruin. Getting his gun from the house he fired at the bear, but only wounded him. The bear was wild with rage and broke the chain which held the trap. The animal then gave chase to Mr. Charbonneau, who ran for the house. When within a few feet of the house he tripped and fell, and in so doing the bear was upon him, seizing him by one of the arms. Charbonneau's father, an old man, came to the rescue with an axe. He struck the bear one blow, when, with a swing of his paw, bruin sent the axe flying and then attacked the old gentleman, knocking him down and tearing his arms and face in a terrible manner. Mrs. Charbonneau saw the scene, when the brute turned his attention to the third antagonist. With a sweep of his paw he knocked her arm from the shoulder to the wrist. In the meantime neighbors were attracted by the cry for help, and one brought a gun. It was some time before he could get a shot for fear of hitting old Mr. Charbonneau, who was under the bear. The chance came, however, and he fired with the muzzle of the gun close to the bear's head. The animal rolled over and in the evening at the Sherbrooke Hotel, he was found to be seriously injured, and it is feared he will not recover. He was very badly torn about the chest, Mr. and Mrs. Charbonneau's injuries were not so serious. The bear weighed 365 pounds.

North Toronto.

Mr. James Parnon, who resides about a mile and a quarter from Richmond Hill, fell off a Metropolitan car on Thursday night near Eglington-avenue. The man was found about 11 p.m. by Constable Tomlinson, and was then recovering consciousness. He had sustained a couple of nasty gashes on the head from the fall, and Dr. Richardson, at the Eglington Church, was called. The doctor found that Parnon was able to return home last night.

In politics Mr. Duncan was a Liberal-Conservative and no man worked more enthusiastically in the party to which he belonged than the late Harcourt Duncan.
