Walsh Victorious.
Rolling the first ten string lap of a special twenty-string match on last Monday evening on the Lewiston, Me., bowling alleys, Archie Walsh, the candle pin wizard of Chelsea, Mass., buried Emery Russell of Lewiston under 142 timbers. Starting off the reel with 101 and never falling below that figure on any string, Walsh made a ten string total of 1121 pins, while the best that Russell could do was a total of 979.
Throughout the evening Walsh was at the top of his game, having his first ball working for perfect hits, practically all the time and cleaning up his spare breaks with wonderful accuracy. Russell was not up to his usual form of this season and in addition the greater portion of the hard luck of the game fell to his share.
A summary of the evening's rolling shows that Walsh made seven strikes and eighteen spares, good for 196 extra pins. He cleaned up twenty tens and missed six spares. Russell made one strike and sixteen spares, good for ninety-three extra pins. He made twenty tens and missed ten spares.
The players were: Archie Walsh—101, 101, 107, 109, 123, 112, 107, 130, 108, 123—1121. Emery Russell—88, 108, 98, 98, 82, 106, 96, 114, 103, 87—979.

AUSTRIA ALSO
Washington, April 12.—Austrian and Bulgarian representatives are endeavoring to approach Entente diplomats in Switzerland on the subject of peace.
