What a perfect look of patient longing, Of love which shone so clear, And I prayed the Lord for his safe coming, For I felt she knew no fear.

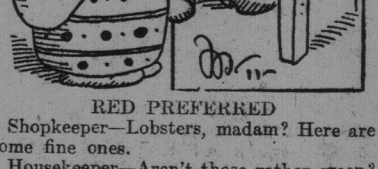
IN LIGHTER VEIN
