

SECTION IX.—EXAMINATIONS.

1. Examinations are held at the close of each Term in the subjects of Lecture during that Term.
2. All Undergraduate Students of the College are required to attend the Examinations in every department or branch prescribed by the University of Toronto, as necessary for Students of their respective standings.
3. Students or Occasional Students are not required to attend the Examinations, unless they are Candidates for Prizes or Honors, or desire to obtain certificates of Attendance.
4. Candidates for Prizes or Honors are arranged, according to their proficiency, in two classes, and those who are not Candidates for Prizes or Honors are similarly arranged in the third class.
5. Undergraduates, who are Candidates for Honors, if they have passed the College Examinations during the 1st and 3rd years of their Course, are required to attend the University Examinations for those years, only in those departments in which they are Candidates for Honors.
6. Undergraduates, who are not Candidates for Honors, if they have passed the College Examinations during the 1st and 3rd years of their Course, are not required to attend the University Examinations for those years in any department.
