factories, pop. 650.

Bear Island—see McPherson's Ferry.

Bear River, (east side) a village in Annapolis Co., 14
miles from Annapolis, fare 50c., pop. 300.

Bear River, (west side) a village in Digby Co., 9 miles
from Digby, fare 40c., it contains twenty stores, three
hotels, an iron foundry, two tanneries, several saw, lath and
shingle mills, and several shipyards, pop. 1200.

Beaver Bank, a post village in Halifax Co., a station on
the I. C. R., 16 miles from Halifax, fare 48c., it contains
two stores and two saw mills. There are extensive slate
quarries in the vicinity. Pop. 220.

Beaver Bank, North, a post office in Halifax Co., pop. 15.

Beaver Brook, a post settlement in Colchester Co., 9 miles
from Truro, fare 25c., pop. 110.

Beaver Cove, a post office in Cape Breton Co., pop. 10.

Beaver Island, near Cape Canso, there is a lighthouse here.
