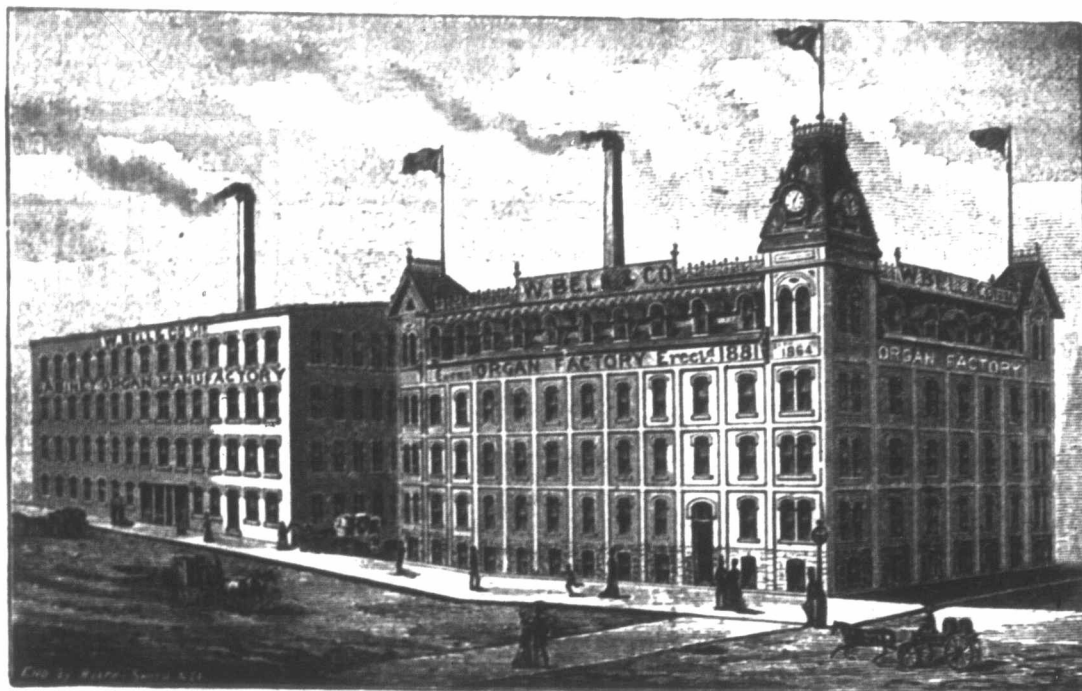

Thus you know beforehand, for nothing, whether you are going to get a patent or not, and no attorney's fee is charged unless you do get a Patent. An attorney will not be paid for his services in obtaining a Patent until he has secured it. Inventors prepared to file. Applications in respect of Rejected, Abandoned, or Forfeited Cases made. Very often valuable inventions are saved in these classes of cases. If you have undertaken to secure your own patent and failed, a skillful handling of the case may lead to success. Send me a written request addressed to the Commissioner of Patents that he recognize **GEORGE E. LEMON**, of Washington, D.
