Of M. P. Davis, and others, Provisional Directors of the Lake Manitoba Railway and Canal Company; praying for an Act to amend their Act of incorporation.

The Honorable Mr. Read, (Quinté), from the Joint Committee on the Printing of Parliament, presented their First Report, recommending the reduction of the Quorum to Nine Members.

On motion of the Honorable Mr. Read (Quinté), seconded by the Honorable Mr. Girard, it was

Ordered, That the said Report be adopted.

The Honorable Mr. Lacoste presented to the House, in compliance with section 91 of the Dominion Lands Act, chapter 54 of the Revised Statutes of Canada, copies of the Regulations which have been sanctioned by the Privy Council since the close of last Session. Also, as required by section 5 of the Act 50-51 Victoria, chapter 32, a copy of the Regulations for the control and management of the Rocky Mountains Park of Canada, sanctioned by Order in Council of the 27th November, 1889.
