An Act respecting the Yukon Mining, Trading and
Transportation Company (Foreign).

WHEREAS the Yukon Mining, Trading and Transportation Company (Foreign) has, by its petition, prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore Her Majesty, by
5 and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of
Commons of Canada, declares and enacts as follows:—

Preamble.

1. The Act respecting the Yukon Mining, Trading and Transportation Company (Foreign), being chapter 91 of the statutes of 1897, is hereby revived and declared to be in force.

10 **2.** Section 20 of the said Act is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof it is enacted that the line of railway mentioned in section 7 of the said Act shall be commenced, and three hundred thousand dollars expended thereon within two years after the passing of this Act, and the said railway shall be finished and
15 put in operation within five years after the passing of this Act, otherwise the powers conferred upon the said company by Parliament shall cease and be null and void as respects so much of the said railway as then remains uncompleted.
