48. It shall be the duty of the Law Clerk of this House to revise all public bills after their first reading, and to certify thereon that the same are correct ; and in every subsequent stage of such bills, the Law Clerk shall be responsible for the correctness of such bills, should they be amended. And he shall prepare a breviat of every public bill previous to the second reading thereof.—B. ~~172~~ ²¹⁹
