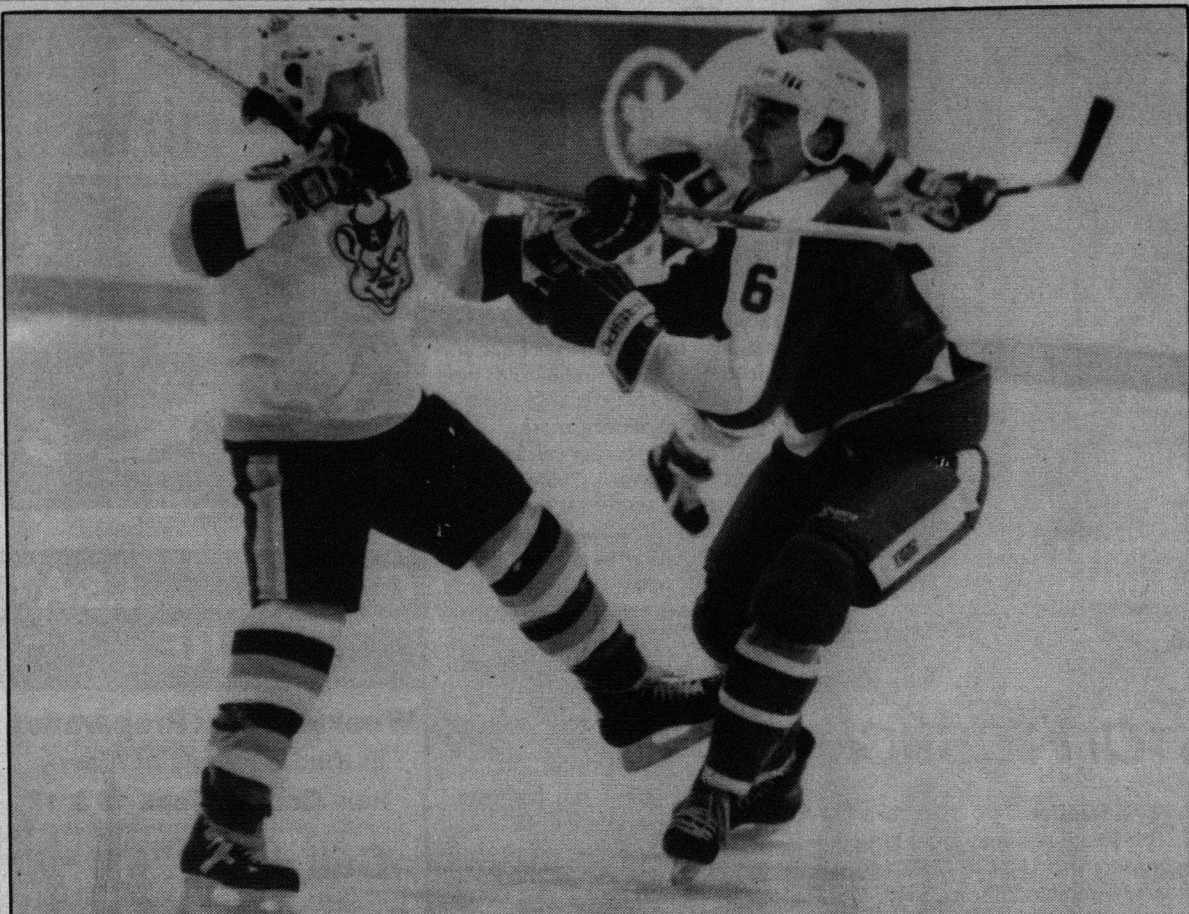

## September is hockey season

September is here and that means hockey isn't far behind. The Bears hockey team has taken to the ice already and they will play their first exhibition game Wednesday night at Varsity Arena when the Oiler rookies come to town.

This will be the third encounter

between the Bears and the Oiler rookies. The Bears won last year's game 5-2. "The Winnipeg Jets had been doing it (playing exhibitions) against the University of Manitoba," said Bear Head Coach Bill Moores. "The Oiler rookies were playing (the) Calgary (rookies) and that's how this was initiated," said the freshman head man.

Coming off a great season, a season which saw the hockey team fall just short at CIAU Nationals, the

game will be the first chance for the coaches to evaluate the talent they have. "This is an opportunity for us to look at our young players," said Moores. "We're not putting anything on the line. Both teams know they're being evaluated," he continued.

Moores plans to play lots of veterans tomorrow night. "We are going to play the veterans just to get continuity," said Moores. Experience and continuity is the edge the Bears have on their opponents. "The Oiler rookies haven't played together, so the team play would be low, but they're talented — that's the trade-off," said Moores. The Bears will be without three veterans tomorrow who are away at National Hockey League camps. Defenceman Ian Herbers and speedy winger Todd Gordon are in Winnipeg, while Dan Wiebe is at his second Quebec Nordiques camp.

The exhibition season could see some Bears play as many as fifteen games. Moores and assistant coaches Peter Esdale and Dan Peacocke will make cuts. However, these cuts won't be based on the game by itself. "This game is part of our overall evaluation," said
