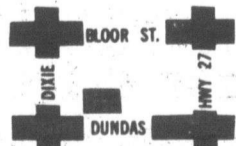

U-turn by Port Credit tykes in season opener

A pair of unassisted third period goals by Allan Widden sparked Port Credit to a hard-fought 2-1 victory over Clarkson tyke A's as the 1973 season of the Mississauga Lacrosse League got under way with a slate of exhibition games this week.

Behind 1-0 at the start of the third period, Port Credit rallied and turned the tide when Widden struck with his solo efforts midway through the frame.

Wayne Peters put Clarkson ahead at the 4:36-minute closing mark of the first period.

Robbie Coates hit for two and Dave Eckert tallied once to provide Clarkson-2 with plenty of power in a 3-0

blanking of Erindale-2. Dave Poulton was in goal.

Dave Vidal scored four times for Dixie Russells, but it all went for naught when Joey Doran, Britt Peer, Ricky Duckewicz and Jeff Chapman joined forces to give Dixie Glencoe a 7-4 win. Doran was responsible for three of the winners' seven markers.

Streetsville got off on a winning foot, blanking Erindale 8-0 with Dean Reynolds scoring five times; Mark Eden, Kevin Prestige and Gerry Ramsey once apiece. Bill Bysma guarded the goal.

MHL sign up date shifted

The sprawling Mississauga Hockey League has accepted a proposal to shift its registration deadline date from Dec 10 to Nov 15.

The move came at the annual general meeting of Mississauga's largest minor sports organization. Delegates from various member areas attended the gathering at Huron Park Recreation Centre Theatre this week, preparing blueprints for next year and electing a slate of officers.

As expected, last year's 1st vice-president (and acting chief of the staff for the closing months of the season) Bill Cornell was elected president for the 1973-74 campaign.

Dave Black was moved into position as successor when he was elected 1st vice-president with Bill Peeling assuming the 2nd vice-president's spot and Len Stewart becoming 3rd vice-president. Secretary is Lou Boaretti and Cal Fletcher is treasurer.

Bob Nicol, Bert Proud and

Keith Ronan were named as newcomers to the 15-member board of directors, joining Russ Biggart, Wally Blagdon, Warren Bradley, Keith Cornell, George Wallace and Mississauga Reps' president John Hospodar.

The MHL is expecting another big boom in its membership, possibly as high as 20 per cent. Last season some 6,000 boys and girls played organized hockey in Mississauga.

The experiment of AAA calibre hockey (a competitive departure from the low-key recreational concept) will continue and include older age groups, too.

At the youngest age levels, the three-minute buzzer system (a familiar sound at one time) will be completely eliminated.

A proposal from the Dixie area to make it compulsory for goaltenders to wear standard protective equipment at all times during the game (including face mask and approved helmet) was accepted.

Football registration

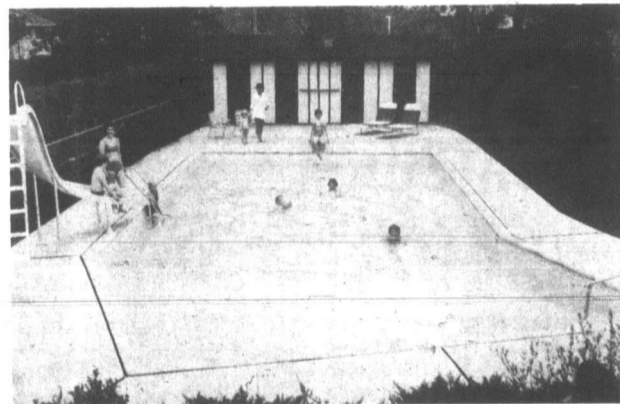
Mississauga Football League officials are expecting a sharp increase in the number of boys wanting to don uniforms for the third season of competition.

Registrations will be held for the four member area clubs on Saturday, May 26 at Burnhamthorpe Community Centre (North East); Springfield Public School, Erin Mills Centre and Meadowvale Community Centre (North West); Cawthra Senior Public School (South East); and Lorne Park Community Centre (South West).

The league, which had some 440 players on 15 teams in its second year, is limited to boys 9 to 14 years of age, weighing between 65 and 140 pounds. Officials expect a 50 per cent jump in enrolment this season.
