

Mr. Churchill went on from the Guard of Honour and the Band further into the Station grounds, to see for himself a Station of the Commonwealth Air Training Plan in action. He was accompanied to the Station by Air Marshal Breadner, Chief of Air Staff RCAF, Air Chief Marshal Sir Charles Portal of the R.A.F., as well as many other officials from Air Force Headquarters, and by Prime Minister Mackenzie King, and other government officials.
