

sixty days beyond the time appointed for opening the treaty.

Brothers. We have now expressed our opinion of the proper mode of settling the differences between you and the United States. But as your Nations have desired answers to certain questions, previous to our meeting, and we are disposed to act with frankness, and sincerity, we will give an explicit answer to the great question you have now proposed to us. But before we do this we think it necessary to look back to some former transactions and we desire you patiently to hear us.

Brothers... We do know very well that at the Treaty of Port Stanwix, - twenty five years ago, the River Ohio was agreed on as the boundary between you and the White People of the British Colonies. And we all know that
