Enclosed please find proposed agreement
 to lease a portion of Indian Reservation at
 (St. Louis) from the U.S. Government is made
 by the Indian. Signature of the U.S. is
 part of the holding which I have stated here
 with the consent of Chief Sarge, who is also
 acquainted with the proposed lease.

I have been of the opinion that the
 favorable to the Indians. The lease is a
 piece of property owned by Indian youth and
 the improvement which lease will have to
 make before he can reside on land will
 probably amount to \$1000 all of which by
 lease of land he lease in property.

In carrying out and submitting lease for
 approval by Dept. I am guided solely
 by Section 49 page 15 of Indian Act.
 I may state that lease is a man of very
 good character and reputation.

I trust if you are able that Dept.
 may be able to find other suitable
 land.
