Memorandum for the Prime Minister:

In connection with your McGill address, you may wish to make some reference to the importance of a mutual knowledge of history in the relations between the United States and Canada.

I attach a quotation from a lecture given by Professor Pollard of London University, which may have some relation to what you have in mind. As a matter of fact, much more attention is being given to United States history in Canadian universities, and to Canadian history in United States universities during the past few years. Certainly this should do much to remove misconceptions which have been the result of ignorance of each other's history.
