A defeat in North Bruce will be a blow so heavy that a Government in the condition of this Government cannot, in my judgment, recover from it. They will, of course, in the contest, pretend that they will carry on anyway, but they cannot carry on, and it would just be a lingering death, and not lingering long at that. North Bruce, therefore, has it in its power to put an end to the present stalemate in Canada and give this country a chance to get on its feet. No such opportunity has been offered to a constituency in our history before. May I appeal to you to continue in this fight the splendid work you did in the late campaign and take your part to ensure a Conservative victory in your county. Our advices are that this county can be won. It is not the ordinary case of a newly made minister going back for re-election. It is a case of a government having no right to carry on in the public interest and of one constituency being put in a position to solve the problem of the whole country.
