 Indians received \$436<sup>00</sup> of  
 interest money for distribu-  
 tion in April last, it is thought  
 that the sum of \$125<sup>00</sup> sent  
 for purchase of seed should  
 suffice if proper discretion  
 is used in its distribution.

On reference to previous  
 lists of seed distribution it is  
 observed that many persons  
 have shared therein who are  
 or should be quite able to  
 provide their own seed,  
 notably officers of the Band  
 who are in receipt of salaries,  
 and others who have a consid-  
 erable amount of land under  
 cultivation
