I am in receipt of your letter of the 20th instant in regard to the case of Mrs. Lulu Roberts, and in reply I beg to say that as this woman has married a White man, she is no longer entitled to be treated as an Indian, except in so far as sharing in the distribution of interest or annuity money. If you render medical service to her it will be necessary for you to look to her husband for payment for your services as the Department will not assume any responsibility in the matter.
