Mr. Jones on August, last, I beg to say that, as you have already been informed by Mr. Agent Carter, the Department will not sanction the admission of these two children to your school. The Department will expect you to return them to the custody of their foster parents on the first opportunity and I trust that these instructions will be carried out as soon as possible. The order purchased for this school at a cost of \$8.00, the order purchased should be similar to the one you were authorized to buy for the Oneida No. 2 School.
