Mr.McInnes,-

An Order in Council is requested transferring two parcels of land in the Dragon Lake Indian reserve No.3, containing together 2.37 acres, to the Province of British Columbia for road purposes.

The lands may be described as all those portions of the Dragon Lake Indian reserve No.3 shown coloured in pink on plans numbered Rd.2068 and Rd.2127, of record in the Surveys Branch of the Department of Indian Affairs.

The lands, which have been valued at \$40.00, have been paid for in full by the provincial government.
