## The Prime Minister's second circular letter

On January the 20th, 1938, the Prime Minister addressed a second circular letter to the Premiers of the provinces enclosing the text of the Address to His Majesty, which it was proposed to submit to both Houses of Parliament.

## Reference in Speech from Throne, 1938

"The co-operation of the provinces has been sought with a view to an amendment of the British North America Act, which would empower the Parliament of Canada to enact forthwith a national scheme of unemployment insurance."
