SENTENCE OF A GENERAL COURT-MARTIAL

1. Major Sidney Robert MITCHELL, Canadian Dental Corps, Attached to No.1 Canadian Non-Effective Transit Depot, was tried by General Court-Martial on the 10th day of December 1942, on two charges under Section 19 of the Army Act relating to drunkenness and was found guilty on both charges. He was sentenced to be dismissed from His Majesty's Service.

2. The finding and sentence having been confirmed by the Senior Officer, Canadian Military Headquarters, under and by virtue of the authority conferred upon him by P.C.9586, the charges, finding and sentence were duly promulgated on the 2nd day of February, 1943.
