and from any other available sources of water supply.

A Reserve on the left bank of the Fraser
River opposite the old Shyne Reserve, extending
Northward to a stream called Hull-hut-aid.

*. 100 inches of water from the Hull-hut-aid
and the Kway-ook (or Gunn) streams and
from any other available sources of water supply.

A Reserve of about 100 acres on the left
Bank near the mouth of a tributary of
Oregon Jack Creek flowing into the river about
10 miles up from the Yale Cariboo
Highway Road.

*. 80 inches of water from Oregon Jack
Creek and all other available sources
of water supply.

On the right bank of the Thompson River
on the lower bench near the river, between
the lands of Messrs. Galt and Messrs. Galt and
Cornwall.

*. 30 inches of water from the Spring
near Cheek's house and from all other
available sources of water supply.
