LESSON II.

Time and its Divisions.

Q. Name the principal divisions of time.
A. Seconds, minutes, hours, days, weeks, months, years, and centuries.

Q. Can you repeat the Time Table?

A. Yes: 60 seconds make 1 minute.
60 minutes " 1 hour.
24 hours " 1 day.
7 days " 1 week.
4 weeks (and two or three days) make 1 month.
12 months make 1 year.
100 years " 1 century.

Q. How many days or weeks are there in a year?

A. 365 $\frac{1}{4}$ days, or 52 weeks.

Q. How many days are there in each month?

A. Thirty days hath September,
April, June, and November;
February alone twenty-eight,
And all the rest have thirty-one;
But leap-year coming once in four,
February then hath one day more.

Q. Into how many seasons is the year divided?
A. Into four: called Spring, Summer, Autumn, and Winter.

Q. What are we to learn from this book?

A. Ge-og-ra-phy, or some account of the Earth.

Q. What is the meaning of the word Geography?

A. A written account, or description, of the Earth.

Q. What is the Earth?

A. The Globe on which we live.

A. "In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth."—Genesis i. 1.

Q. What is the shape of the Earth?

A. It is round like an orange.
