

## CHAPTER XX.

*By-Law to raise by a Tax Thirty Pounds for erecting a School House in No. 1 School Section in McKillop, and to increase the said School Section.*

Whereas, in compliance with the Petition of the School Trustees of School Section No. 1 in McKillop, praying that the Sum of Thirty Pounds be raised on said School Section, for the purpose of erecting a School House; also praying that the said School Section may be enlarged:

Be it enacted, by the Warden and Municipal Council of the District of Huron, in pursuance of the Act 4th and 5th Victoria, chap. 10., and the Act 9th Victoria, chapter 40, and 9th Victoria, chapter 20, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That a Tax be raised, levied, assessed and collected, on the inhabitants of the said School Section No. 1 in McKillop, to the extent of Thirty Pounds, free of the expences of assessing, levying, and collecting the said sum; to be applied in the erection of a new School House in the said School Section.

2. And it is further enacted, by the authority of the same, That the following Lots shall be added to the said School Section No. 1 in McKillop, viz. from 5 in Tuckersmith to 18 inclusive; and that the inhabitants thereof shall be liable to be taxed for the proportion of the said Thirty Pounds.
