

"An Act to provide for the better internal Government of that part of this Province which formerly constituted the Province of Upper Canada, by the establishment of Local or Municipal Authorities therein," and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the trustees of the seventh school division aforesaid be hereby empowered and required to levy such rates and taxes as by the 39th section of the 4th & 5th Victoria, chap. 10, directed, to the extent of the prayer of the petition of the said trustees, viz., five pounds eighteen shillings and ten-pence.

2. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the said sum of five pounds eighteen shillings and ten-pence, shall and is hereby required to be laid out and expended by the said trustees in compliance with the estimate accompanying their petition to the Warden and Council, of date 13th May, 1844.

CHAP. V.

By-LAW to enable Thomas Splan and others, Trustees of the 5th School Division in the Township of Goderich, to raise the sum of three pounds five shillings and three-pence, for the repairs of the School-house.

WHEREAS in compliance with the petition of Thomas Splan and others, trustees of the 5th school division of the township of Goderich, it is necessary and expedient that the sum of three pounds five shillings and three-pence be raised, for the repairs of and furnishings to the school-house in the said 5th school division, Be it therefore enacted, by the Warden and Council of the District of Huron in council assembled, under and by virtue of an Act of the Provincial Parliament, entitled "An Act to provide for the better internal Government of that part of this Province which formerly constituted the Province of Upper Canada, by the establishment of Local or Municipal Authorities therein," and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That Thomas Splan and others, trustees as aforesaid, be hereby empowered and required to raise the sum of three pounds five shillings and three-pence, in equal portions, on the resident householders in the said 5th school division.

2. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the said sum of three pounds five shillings and three-pence, when collected, shall be appropriated by the said Thomas Splan and others, trustees as aforesaid, in compliance with the estimate accompanying the petition.
