

## RULE IX.

### **Payment of Fines.**

**ANY** member neglecting to pay the Fines he may have incurred by the foregoing Rules after they shall have been demanded of him, by direction of the company shall be expelled this Society.

### Absence.

Any member absenting himself from three successive meetings (sickness or absence from town excepted) shall no longer be considered a Member of this Society, without being regularly re-admitted: previously paying all Fines he may have incurred.

### **Printed Ruler**

Each Member shall provide himself from the Secretary, with a printed copy of the foregoing Rules, under a penalty of one shilling and three pence, in which shall be inserted the name of each new Member with ink, under a penalty of seven pence half-penny for every omission. And each Member's Book shall be examined by the Secretary at every time of meeting: any Member neglecting to bring said Book, shall pay the fine of one shilling and three pence.

**Every Member shall subscribe his Name to the Rules written in the Company's Books.**
