

BY - LAWS.

[28th September, 1861.

I.

That members may introduce friends not resident in Canada West to the privileges of the Club, for any period not exceeding one fortnight.

[19th December.

II.

That no person shall be eligible to be elected hereafter a member of the Club unless of the age of 21 years, except Officers of Her Majesty's service.

III.

That gentlemen visiting Toronto, although resident in Canada West, may be introduced to the Club and make use of it for a period not exceeding three days on being entered in the Visitors' Book in the usual way. Such introduction not to be repeated more than once in Two Months.

IV.

That the privileges of the Club may be extended to visitors not resident in Canada West for a period beyond a fortnight, provided the sanction of the Committee be first obtained on a representation of the circumstances.
