THE POULTRY SHOW.

The poultry show is having its second season at the Mechanics Hall on Third street. Several hundred of the finest bred-in-the-purple cocks and hens in the province are in attendance with their feathers plumed, their combs looking rosy, and their muscular qualifications unexcelled. No ordinary barnyard fowl are they, not much they represent the most highly bred and highest scoring birds that the province can produce.

The Twin Cities poultry show this year has the patronage of some of the best poultry fanciers in the west. There are on exhibition over 150 birds from Calgary alone and many others from all points on the C.P.R. line between Calgary and Edmonton, and on the C.N.R. line as far east as Vermilion. Among the exhibitors are Gray Bros., of Calgary, with white Wyandottes, which created Polands and Eastons; H. C. Sutor, of Calgary, with white Rocks; Russ Wallace, of Calgary, with Buff Orpingtons; Dr. Frith, of Calgary, with Buff Orpingtons; Karon Bros., of Fort Saskatchewan, with Black Orpingtons; Judge Tipton, Strathcona, with barred Rocks; Columbia Wyandottes and Rhode Is. and Reds; V. T. Richards, Strathcona, with buff Orpingtons; Jos. Thompson Strathcona, with partridge Wyandottes, white Leghorns and white Wyandottes, and J. I. Lavigne, Strathcona, with eight or nine varieties.

Edmonton Exhibitors.

Edmonton exhibitors are Knowle Bros. with white Wyandottes; Thos. Pasmore with white Rocks; Wm. Palmer with Light Brahma; Alderman Lundy with Buff Cochins; Alderman Manson with Barred Rocks; H. V. Shaw with white Wyandottes; Mrs. Heathcote with white Leghorns. This year's show is in marked contrast with previous years, the large number of entries in the utility breed and in the general high quality of the birds. The largest entry is in the Buff Orpington class, showing this to be a favorite Alberta breed. White Wyandottes and Barred Rocks are also prominent.

Show Specialties.

Specialties of the show are numerous and interesting. J. I. Lavigne of Strathcona has a frank bird in that it has white hair instead of feathers. He calls it "The Klondike hairy fowl." H. V. Shaw, of Fort Saskatchewan, has a first cross of a jungle fowl from which the modern domestic breeds have sprung. The poultry exhibition is supplemented by a show of canaries, homer pigeons owned by R. Worsley and birds owned by W. J. Bown, of Edmonton.

Grand Concert.

The directors of the association have arranged for a grand concert in the assembly room of the Mechanics Hall this evening at 8 o'clock. Premier Rutherford will occupy the chair and an address will be given by Hon. W. T. Finlay, minister of agriculture. The programme will be as follows:

Prize Cup.

The list of awards and special prizes to be awarded this year in addition to the regular prize list is most extensive. The Premier's Cup, which is donated by Premier Rutherford is the highest aim of the poultry fanciers. This cup was won by an Orpington bred last year and was won by Karon Bros. of Fort Saskatchewan with Black Orpingtons. This year the cup will be contested by Plymouth Rocks of all varieties. A \$10 medal goes with the cup and becomes the property of the winner.

The Members' Cup is offered for the best bird bred and raised by a member of the association. The cup is to be held one year but the medals become the winner's property.

Robt. Smith's Cup is the prize for the best Orpington bred and raised by a member of the association. The cup is to be held one year but the medals become the winner's property.

THE POULTRY SHOW.

The grand concert held in the Mechanics Hall Wednesday, under the auspices of the Alberta Twin Cities Poultry and Pet Stock association, drew a crowd that packed the building to the doors. Premier Rutherford occupied the chair and a most entertaining program of songs, recitations, and speeches was carried through most successfully.

Hon. W. T. Finlay, minister of agriculture, spoke before the gathering on the poultry industry. He said that the unfavorable condition of the poultry industry was one of the first things brought to his attention on assuming office as minister of agriculture. He decided then to use every effort to change this condition of things. The secretary of the association, Mr. W. A. Foley, was secured as poultry superintendent and it was gratifying to see the good work which he has done and the co-operation he has received from all quarters. Mr. Finlay hoped that the poultry being imported annually from the eastern provinces would gradually decrease.

Cup Winners.

The Grand Challenge cup and medal donated by Premier Rutherford for the contest this year was for Plymouth Rocks. Russ Wallace, of Calgary, and a Plymouth Rock which took 222 points, only losing by 7-12ths of a point.

Gray Bros. of Calgary, won the Association cup and medal for the best bird bred and raised by a member of the Poultry association.

Germany's Imports Decrease.

Berlin, Jan. 21.—Germany's imports in 1908 amounted to \$2,184,000,000, a decrease of \$66,500,000 from 1907, and exports to \$1,701,250,000, a decrease of \$64,750,000. Precious metals are included in these figures.

TUESDAY'S GRAIN MARKETS.

Winnipeg, Man., January 20.—Chicago showed a considerable range of fluctuations. May varying 1/4 lower, July was down 1/4 and September 1/4. In Minneapolis May was off 1c and July 1/4. The Winnipeg market held very firm, January breaking only 1/4 for the morning, and May the same, while July was without pressure, either sell or buy. Export inquiry was slow, receipts were light and offerings still lighter. Coarse grains were quiet. May flux in Duluth was off 1/4c, while Winnipeg May flux was unchanged. Breadstuffs report indicates a decrease in visible wheat of nearly 2,000 for the week, against an increase last year of 1,042,000.

Although \$5.50 to \$6.00 was made, a decline to \$5.25 bought a large slice of crop, while in Minneapolis it was higher on a light supply, \$5.25 to \$6.00 buying the bulk of steers. Choice hogs were sold at \$8.00 to \$8.75. Supply was soon cleaned up, the bullish influence being light support. For choice lambs, \$10.00 to \$10.75 was freely paid.
