

The irrigation system already in operation extends to all parts of the big tract, and large crops of rice, corn, cotton and other

products are being raised.

The Mormons have several colonies in the semi-arid regions of the State of Chihuahau, Mexico. They have converted portions of the desert into veritable cases and are noted for their prosperity and good citizenship. The prosperity and good citizenship. The water supply for irrigating the 35,000 water supply for irrigating the \$5,000 acres that are to be colonized is at present obtained from the San Diego river, and if that stream should not provide a sufficient quantity of the life-giving fluid an unlimited amount can be obtained from the Rio Grande, which the land fromts for many miles. It is planned by the colonists to establish a number of large industrial establishments in connection with their farms. These will include a rice mill cottonseed of mill, soap factory, fibre extracting plant and other manufacturing concerns.
