Dresden Man Drops Dead While Milking a Cow—Local Declaration of Interest to Drivers—Police Island Grape Crop.

The exports of Stratford district show an increase this year over last of \$48,596.

The people of Hepworth have started an oil well. They let the contract of a 500-foot well to a Wisconsin man, and he is already down 75 feet.

Mr. Alex. Haas has sold his dwelling house, opposite McLean's livery stables, Wallingford, to a party for \$4,000. Property is beginning to move in Wallingford.

Rev. Mr. Scott, of Knox College, has received a call to Hespeler Presbyterian Church. He will receive a stipend of \$900 per annum, a month's holidays, and a free manse.

A syndicate has been formed to go into the timber trade extensively on Pelee Island. The Keokule place has been leased, and options have been secured for the purchase of 500 acres more.

Mrs. Elizabeth Harvey died recently at the residence of her son, Andrew Harvey, near Port Stanley. Deceased was born in Nova Scotia 79 years ago. Her husband died many years ago at Springfield.

The grape crop of Pelee Island was very heavy this year. The fruit was all gathered before the frosts, and will mostly be used for making wine. Growers secured from \$12 to \$15 per ton for the grapes.

Mrs. James Belchamber, of Sarnia, died there on Saturday morning from a paralytic stroke. Mrs. Belchamber was the widow of the late James Belchamber, and was aged about 74 years. She had been a resident of Sarnia for over 40 years.

P. Irving conducted a successful sale for John Walters on Oct. 3 at East Oxford Friday. Implements and farm stock brought good prices, cows averaging about \$20. A team of horses belonging to D. Goodall were sold this week to W. Wood for \$201.

There has been an outbreak of swine plague in Malden, and 22 hogs, belonging to J. D. Burke, have been destroyed by order of Dr. Perdue, the government veterinary inspector. Two hogs, belonging to Joseph Roubidoux, of Amherstburg, have also been destroyed.

A very sad house was that of Mr. Eglin's, at Dresden, on Friday. Mr. Eglin dropped dead while milking the cow in the pasture. He had never known a day's sickness, so the calamity which has fallen on his family is the more painful because unexpected. Deceased was 78 years old.

Mr. A. D. McDonald, of St. Thomas, died very suddenly at Aylmer on Saturday. He was apparently well while doing some business in Palmer's furniture store, when he was suddenly taken ill, and expired before medical assistance could be summoned. Deceased was well known and very popular.

One of Howard's oldest and most respected citizens died on Friday—Mr. Henry Gerson. The deceased, who was 60 years of age, had been ill for about

eight months. Mr. Gerson settled in Howard in 1844, and was an active Liberal in politics and took a keen interest in all matters pertaining to the township.

LONDON DEFEATED AT TORONTO.

The Toronto World thus describes Saturday's final game for the intermediate Rugby championship:

"Varsity II, now holds the intermediate cup. They defeated London in the final game on the campus by 64 to 5 on Saturday. The half-time score was 19-1. This game not only gives them the championship, but the combination of the halves was perfect. It was this that made such a show of the Forest City players. They were never in it at any stages of the game, and Varsity scored as they pleased. In fact, their opponents were bewildered by the brilliant play of the halves, and on two occasions stood and watched them go over the line."

London was without Reid and Stringer while they played Woodworth, who has been playing with St. Catharines at quarter, and "Chick" McCrae, the old Queen's star at half. The latter proved to be about the poorest half on the field, and not only this, but he resorted to his hands and feet. Varsity warned the referee. "Varsity played the team they have been playing all season. The game was fairly free from rough play although Ford and Varsity were ruled off in the first half, while Ransford had two ribs broken and had to give up. Spence going to Varsity's team to even up.
