

# Victoria West

## Chief of Fire Department Water Supply is Inadequate

**Council Will Attempt  
Matter Rectified  
Immediately.**

(From Tuesday's Daily News)  
Victoria West is in grave danger of suffering from a water shortage due to the inadequacy of its water supply. This disturbing fact was made known to the council yesterday at its regular meeting in the City Hall. Chief Watson, presented the matter in his own name. It was decided to appoint a committee to communicate with the Esquimalt and Nanaimo Water Works Co. on the matter, and to ascertain what are the legal rights of the city, in respect to the water supply, and to the water supply.
