THE ADDITION TO OUR PUBLIC LIABILITIES HAS BEEN CAUSED SOLELY BY THE BUILDING OF THE TRANS-CONTINENTAL RAILWAY WHICH, THOUGH NOT YET COMPLETED, HAS ALREADY ENHANCED THE VALUE OF REAL ESTATE IN THE TERRITORY THROUGH WHICH IT PASSES TO AN EXTENT EQUAL TO THE ESTIMATED TOTAL COST OF THE ROAD; AND IF THIS DOES NOT MEAN A WISE INVESTMENT OF PUBLIC MONEY, THEN WISDOM IN CONNECTION WITH NATIONAL FINANCE HAS NO MEANING.

A Newcastle despatch announcing the assignment of the Miller Tanning Extract Co. of Millerton, Northumberland county, has caused much surprise in St. John. The concern was established a long time ago, the late Mr. Duff Miller, new Brunswick's Agent General in London, being a prominent member. The company—an English one—has a capital of £100,000 of which £20,000 was paid up in addition to the Miller factory there was one at Mortmore Northumberland county but it was destroyed by fire for some time past Mr. James Beveridge president of a pulp and paper company on the North Shore has been managing the tanning company's affairs so far as is known in St. John the company had been meeting all its obligations.

SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH WEST LAND REGULATIONS.

Any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency, on certain conditions, by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader.

Duties—Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres solely owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister.

In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter section alongside his homestead. Price \$1.00 per acre. Duties—Must reside upon the homestead or pre-emption six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry, (including the time required to earn homestead patent) and cultivate fifty acres extra.

A homesteader who has exhausted his homestead right and cannot obtain a pre-emption may enter for a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a house worth \$200.00.
