"The Board of Education desires that Boards of Trustees maintaining Graded Schools shall care-ly arrange, year by year, that any *transfer* of Teachers in their employ from one department to Ether, be made at the close of the School Term in which such departments are to be annually specied Should, however, exceptional circumstances, in any year, render it necessary that any user be made at another time, such exceptional transfers, if forwith notified to the Education Except the Trustees, shall not render the departments ineligible for classification in such year, tapting always the cases where the Teacher shall have been in the employ of the Irustees, (imme-tack) preceding the time of the annual inspection), for a period less than that required by 5 (3) (1) MNote 1."-April, 1881.
